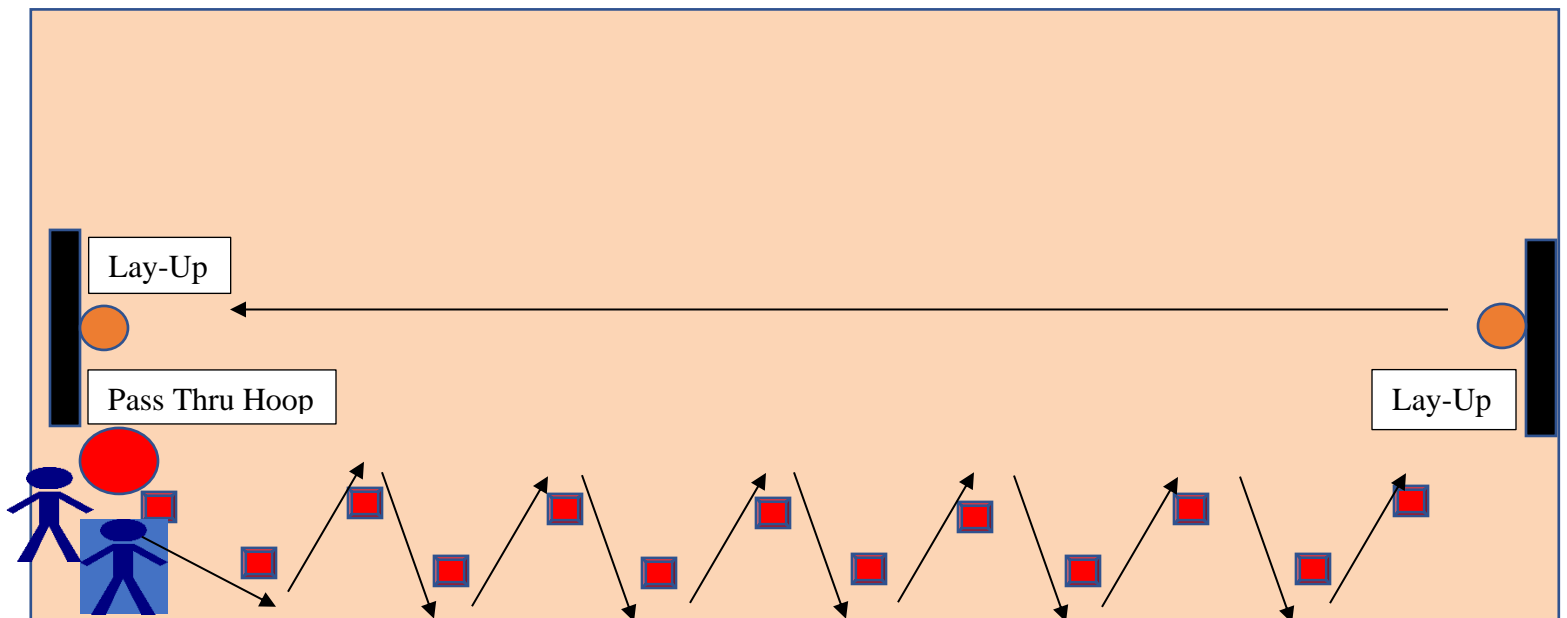


KCCC is taking several steps to enhance the health and safety of the event for participants, volunteers, and staff:

- **Masks:** all athletes, volunteers, and staff will be required to wear masks at all times during event, unless facility guidelines specify otherwise.
- **Physical Distancing:** maintain at least a 6-foot distance between each other.
- **Cleaning and Disinfecting:** extra handwashing and hand sanitizer stations will be available at the event.
- **Facility Guidelines:** KCCC events will adhere to all safety protocols required at each of our host facilities.
- **Spectators:** To adhere to all facility capacity limits, maintain proper social distancing, and limit contact tracing, NO spectators will be allowed at the event.
- If anyone is experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19, they will abstain from the event (including but not limited to: fever, chills, cough, sore throat, and shortness of breath).

- Companies may enter three teams in the competition. A Men's team consisting of two men, a Women's team of two women, and a Coed team with 1 man and 1 woman. Entrants in the Coed competition cannot participate in the Men's or Women's events.
- **A team representative must check-in at event, no less than 30 minutes prior to their scheduled game time and confirm enough participants to play. Team rosters will not be required, but only players who are registered for KCCC and who have signed the KCCC waiver will be eligible. Teams will randomly be checked for player eligibility. Make sure each participant has a photo ID available at game time in the event of a random check. Failure to show IDs at a random check will result in a forfeit, as well as any point penalties resulting from a forfeit.**
- Each team will compete in an agility course and a shooting contest. The scores of each participant will be added together to give a team score. Each of the company's teams will add their scores together to give an overall company score.
- The agility course will consist of dribbling, shooting and passing by both participants. See layout below. The first competitor will dribble around cones down the court and complete a lay-up. He or she will then run down the to the other end of the court, complete a lay-up, and pass the ball through a hoop to his or her teammate. The teammate will then run the course. This will be a timed event in which you are rewarded points for as quickly as you can successfully complete the course. See chart below.

- The shooting contest will consist of 10 free throws, 5 shots from the top of the key, and 5 shots from different areas that the shooter can choose. The 5 shots from which to choose will be marked on the floor with spots positioned farther from the basket being worth more points.
- The combined scores from each companies' teams will be totaled and used to give the company an overall score.
- Basketballs will be provided by KCCC. Teams can bring their own basketballs if desired. Men must use a men's sized ball and women may use either the women's or men's size.
- Please ask that your participants have their ID with them at all KCCC events. For more information on protests/use of illegal players, please see the KCCC Protest Policy.



Scoring for agility course is as follows:

Under 35 seconds: 20 points

:36-:45 seconds: 15 points

:46-:55 seconds: 10 points

:56-:65 seconds: 5 points

Any time over :65 seconds is 1 point
