# 2021 KANSAS CITY CORPORATE CHALLENGE BIKE RACE

**KCCC is taking several steps to enhance the health and safety of the event for participants, volunteers, and staff:**

- **Masks:** all athletes, volunteers, and staff will be required to wear masks at all times during event, unless facility guidelines specify otherwise.
- **Physical Distancing:** maintain at least a 6-foot distance between each other.
- **Cleaning and Disinfecting:** extra handwashing and hand sanitizer stations will be available at the event.
- **Facility Guidelines:** KCCC events will adhere to all safety protocols required at each of our host facilities.
- **Spectators:** To adhere to all facility capacity limits, maintain proper social distancing, and limit contact tracing, NO spectators will be allowed at the event.
- If anyone is experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19, they will abstain from the event (including but not limited to: fever, chills, cough, sore throat, and shortness of breath).

## Event Schedule – Tuesday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021

W19-29, M 30-39	6:00 p.m. – 6:45 p.m.
W 50-59, M 40-49	6:45 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.
W 40-49, M 50-59	7:30 p.m. – 8:15 p.m.

- Each company may enter two male and two female participants in the Bike Race in each of the following age groups: 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59 and 60+.
- Entrants will be placed in the appropriate 5-year age group **according to their age as of December 31, 2021** and scored in the following age groups: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, and 65+.
- Participants will race during their designated race time as indicated on the schedule below. **Race times may vary depending on the number of participants in each age group.**
- Check-in will be a drive thru format and participants will be checked in by staff upon entering the facility. We ask that you remain in your vehicle during this time.
  - During this process, you will receive your bib and timing chip.

- Chip timing will be used for this event. You will receive your timing chip at check-in on race day. Timing chips will be collected at the end of your race. NO CHIP = NO TIME
- After being checked in, you will park your vehicle and then proceed to the track where you will ride your race. Upon completion, we ask that participants gather their belongings and exit the facility.
- The format for the event will be a time trial. Participants will race against the clock for the best time within their age division.
- The distance for the time trial will be 3 miles (TWO laps).
- Triathlon handlebars and disc wheels will be allowed. Recumbent Bicycles are **NOT** allowed.
- All cyclists must always wear and have latched a CPSC, ASTM, or SNELL approved helmet, throughout the race, or they will be disqualified. Headphones are NOT allowed on the course.
- KCCC recommends all participants have their own equipment and don't share other's bikes, helmets, etc.
- No outside competitors, for "pacing" purposes allowed on the course. All participants must have a race number and timing chip, provided at check-in.
- No pets allowed; service animals are welcome.
- All cyclists must finish under their own power, in order to receive points or medals.
- Drafting is not permitted.
- Individual times can be viewed on the timing company's website.
- Results will not be posted until the entire event has concluded and will not be finalized until the Monday following the event.
- Gates to the Kansas Speedway will open to participants at 4:30pm.

## SCORING THE BIKE RACE MEET

- The Bike Race will be held as a "Meet". Individuals will compete within their age group against competitors from all divisions, but results will be scored by division. Categories for competition are:
  - ✓ **Men's and Women's; 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65+**
- The top eight finishers in each age group, by division, in the Bike Race will be awarded points toward your company's Bike Race "Meet Points" as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	10
2 <sup>nd</sup>	8
3 <sup>rd</sup>	6
4 <sup>th</sup>	5

5 <sup>th</sup>	4
6 <sup>th</sup>	3
7 <sup>th</sup>	2

- After “Meet Points” are accumulated from all finishers in the Bike Race Meet, company winners will be determined and points will be awarded, by division, to your *overall* KCCC total, as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	40
2 <sup>nd</sup>	34
3 <sup>rd</sup>	28
4 <sup>th</sup>	24

Place	Points
5 <sup>th</sup>	20
6 <sup>th</sup>	16
7 <sup>th</sup>	12

Place	Points
9 <sup>th</sup>	8
10 <sup>th</sup>	6
11 <sup>th</sup>	4
12 <sup>th</sup>	2

- Medals and additional “medal points” will be awarded toward your *overall* KCCC Total for the top three finishers in each age group in the Bike Race. These medals and “medal points” will be awarded overall by age group, not by division. Medal points will be scored as follows:

Place	Points
1 <sup>st</sup>	3
2 <sup>nd</sup>	2
3 <sup>rd</sup>	1

The KCCC will award participation points for all competitors in the Bike Race. To receive participation points, competitors must complete the event as designed (riders must finish the bike race under their own power).
