# TRAP SHOOTING

Check-in will begin at 9:00am. **All participants must check-in by 10:00 a.m.**
- DIVISIONS – TBA – 12:30pm-3:00pm.  
Check-in will begin at 12:00pm. **All participants must check-in by 12:30 p.m.**

Flight number assignments for companies will be made after divisions are announced on February 23<sup>rd</sup>.

- No spectators beyond the sidewalk/ fence.
- **No late check-ins will be allowed!**
- Keep your gun pointed in the direction of the shooting field at all times. DO NOT put it on your shoulder or wave it around, even if it is empty.
- Stand at the yardage where you are shooting, don't drop back a yard or two between shots.
- If you have a misfired shell or anything goes wrong with your gun, keep it pointed in the direction of the shooting field.
- Eye and ear protection required.
- Report any unsafe conditions IMMEDIATELY!
- If you do not observe these safety rules, you will not be allowed to shoot.
- Hunters Safety Course highly recommended.
- Each company may enter one man and one woman in the Trap Shooting competition.
- Participants will be placed in squads at check-in. Please be prepared to stay during the entire time block for your division. Results will be posted, and medals presented at the end of each time block.

- Two rounds of 25 regulation targets will be shot. All broken targets will be scored. No handicaps will be used.
- KCCC will be using (7) trap stations, keeping (2) open for practice.
- No restrictions on guns except that:
  - ✓ Participants must use a 12 gauge bore or smaller.
  - ✓ Shells must be no larger than three drams of powder, and no larger than 1 1/8 oz. of shot.
  - ✓ 7 1/2, 8, and 9 shot are allowed.
- Range of targets will be 16 yards.
- If there is a tie, the tie breaker will be determined by the longest single run of consecutive hits anywhere in the 50 targets. **If still tied, then second longest & etc. until tie is broken.**
- Judges will be used to determine hits and misses. Confirm with the judge your score after you shoot. After that, your score is considered final.
- **Participants must provide their own guns and shells.** Shells may be purchased at KCTA. House shells 12 gauge or 20 gauge.
- Contact KCTA at 816-532-4427 for operational days/hours. Company participants MUST notify KC Trap staff that they are with KCCC to receive a practice discount.
- Participants must inform the Kansas **City Trap Association** that they are KCCC shooters to receive discounts for practice and company qualifiers.
- In the event of bad weather, please use the KCCC rain-out number 913-686-6030x15 or check the KCCC website ([www.kccorporatechallenge.com](http://www.kccorporatechallenge.com)).
- Please refer to the KCCC Point System for information on points for Trap Shooting.
