DATES / TIMES: Saturday, June 29, 2024
7:30 a.m. First Pulls

LOCATION: Longview Lake Swim Beach

(1/4 mile south of Longview Marina entrance on Raytown Road)

WEIGH-IN DATE/TIME: Thursday, June 27, 2024, 10am-6pm or Friday, June 28, 2024 10am-4pm

- Companies may enter one coed team into the event, maximum number of participants is 7 (with a minimum of two women).
- A 1400-pound weight limit, per team, will apply.
- Companies must send participants to one of the weigh-in times. Full team does not need to be present at weigh-in but must make sure the last person to weigh in will not put team over limit. If that person puts the team over the limit, the company will need to find a new person or compete down 1 person.
- 1 person is allowed to not be present at weigh-in. Their name and weight must be typed on company letterhead, notarized, and brought to a weigh-in session. Photo I.D. must be brought by this participant to the event check-in on Saturday to receive their wrist band.
- No event day substitutions (only competitors that weighed-in and 1 proxy are allowed to pull)
- In the event of bad weather, please use the KCCC rain-out number 913-686-6030x15 or check the KCCC website (www.kccorporatechallenge.com).
- The only articles of clothing that can be removed during weigh-in are shoes and shirts (women must wear sports bras if removing their shirt). Please have your participants wear shorts and t-shirts to the weigh-in to speed up the process.
- No spikes, cleats, etc. Tennis shoes, aqua socks, or bare feet only. An inspection of all team member shoes will take place before each pull. Those participants found to be wearing illegal shoes will not be allowed to compete. Gloves are allowed and recommended. Pets not allowed on beach.
- The Tug of War rope is 120' in length and 1 1/4" in width.
- Participants in the Tug may use feet or hands only to gain foothold, no tools. They will not be allowed extensive time to dig in and get set. There will be a one-minute time limit per tug. The winning team will pull another team two feet across the line. If no team has been pulled over the line at the end of the one-minute time limit, the tug will go to the team who has the advantage at that time.
- Please ask that your participants have an ID with them at all KCCC events. Participants who are asked and are not able to produce an ID at an Event will be forfeited from the event. Please see the KCCC Protest Policy for more information on protests and disqualifications.
- Please refer to the KCCC Point System for information on points for Tug of War.
- *For the health and safety of all KCCC participants, staff, and volunteers, we ask anyone experiencing symptoms of illness to abstain from the event.*
