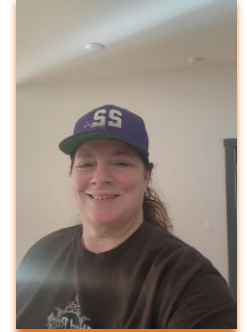

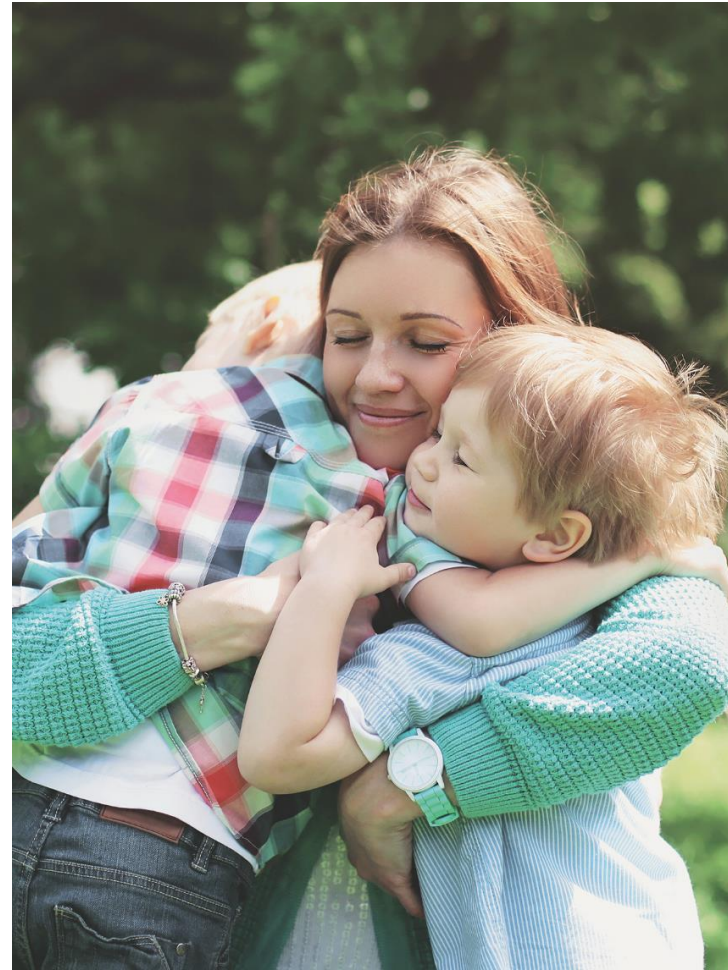


# Who We Are

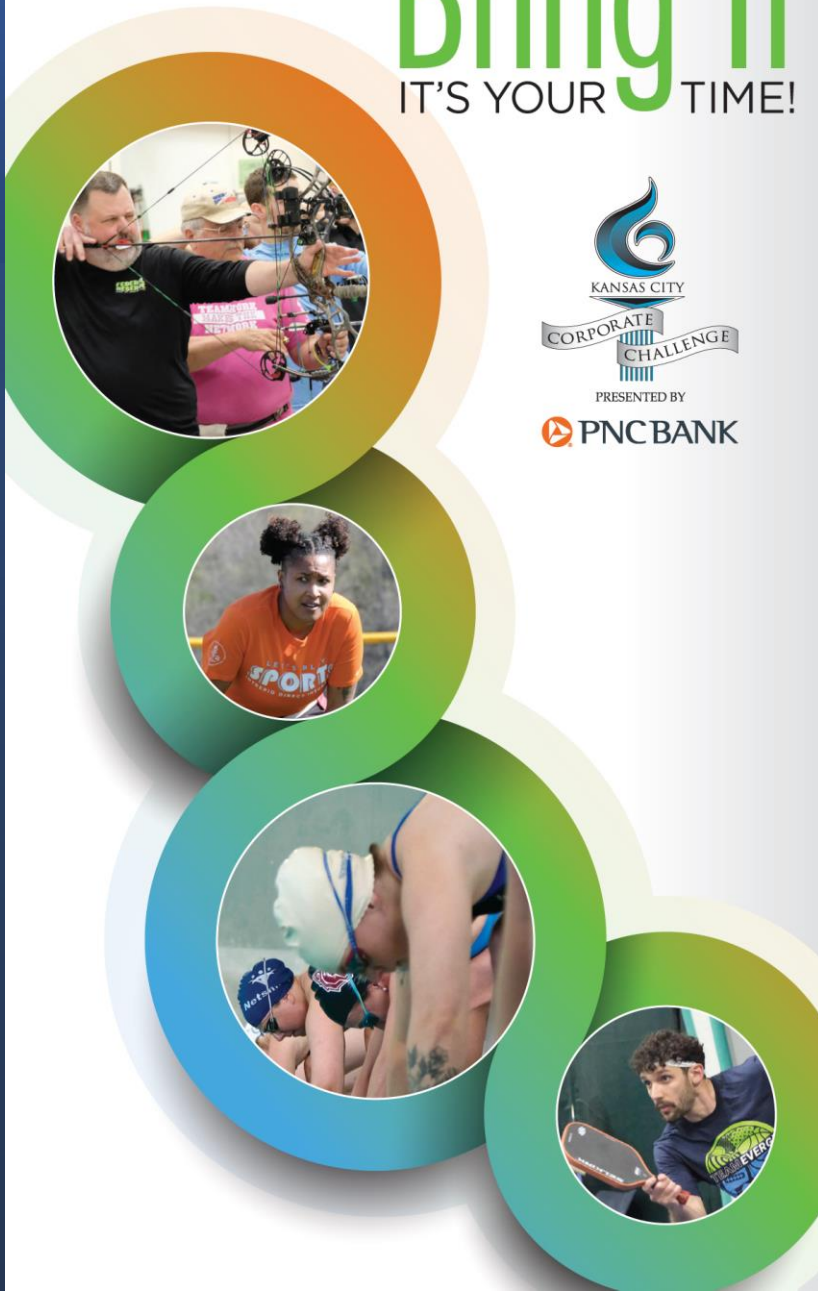
