



## 2026 KANSAS CITY CORPORATE CHALLENGE

# BIKE RACE



**DATE / TIMES:** Tuesday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and Wednesday, 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026

➤ **Schedule**

- Tuesday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026
  - Age Groups: M&W 70+, M&W 60-69, W 50-59, M&W 30-39, M&W 19-29
- Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026
  - Age Groups: M 50-59, M&W 40-49
    - Check-in both days will begin at 4:30p.m. and conclude at 7:15p.m. Participants must begin their ride by 7:30p.m. No participants will be allowed to start their ride after this time.

- Each company may enter two male and two female participants in the Bike Race in each of the following age groups: 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, and 70+.
- Entrants will be placed in the appropriate 5-year age group **according to their age as of December 31, 2026**, and scored in the following age groups: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, and 70+.
- Check-in will be conducted in a drive-through format. Participants will be checked in by staff upon entering the facility. We ask that you remain in your vehicle during this time.
  - You will receive your bib and timing chip at check-in.
- Chip timing will be used for this event. You will receive your timing chip at check-in on race day. Timing chips will be collected at the end of your race. NO CHIP = NO TIME.
- After checking in, you will park your vehicle and then proceed to the track where you will complete your ride.
- The format for the event will be a time trial. Participants will race against the clock for the best time within their age division.
- The distance for the time trial will be 3 miles (TWO laps).
- Triathlon handlebars and disc wheels will be allowed. Recumbent bicycles are **NOT** allowed. Motorized bicycles are **NOT** allowed.
- At all times when participating in the KCCC Bike Race, all participants who are mounted on a bicycle shall wear a securely fastened helmet that meets the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) standard for bicycle helmets. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- The following types of bicycles will not be allowed on the course: tandem bicycles, electric bicycles, and unicycles. If you have a question as to whether a bike is allowed or not, please reach out to the

Games Director. If there is a question of bicycle eligibility, the Games Director and/or Race Committee will have final say.

- Headphones are NOT allowed on the course.
- KCCC recommends all participants have their own equipment and do not share other's bikes, helmets, etc.
- No outside competitors, for "pacing" purposes allowed on the course. All participants must have a race number and timing chip, provided at check-in.
- No pets allowed; service animals are welcome.
- All cyclists must finish under their own power, to receive points or medals.
- Drafting is not permitted.
- Individual times can be viewed on the timing company's website: MTecResults.com
- Official KCCC results will be posted once the entire event has concluded. Final results will be posted no later than the Monday following the event.
  - Please direct all timing/scoring questions to the KCCC office.
- Gates to the Kansas Speedway will open to participants at 4:30pm.
- KCCC will allow additional athletes beyond the "normal" allotment per age group. These athletes will need to register via the [RunSignup website](#). Athletes participating in this category are NOT eligible for KCCC points or places. A registration fee will be assessed at time of registration on the [RunSignup website](#).
  - These additional slots are open to non-KCCC athletes as well.

## SCORING THE BIKE RACE MEET

- The Bike Race will be held as a "Meet". Individuals will compete within their age group against competitors from all divisions, but results will be scored by division. Categories for competition are:
  - ✓ **Men's and Women's; 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, and 70+.**
- The top eight finishers in each age group, by division, in the Bike Race will be awarded points toward your company's Bike Race "Meet Points" as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	10
2 <sup>nd</sup>	8
3 <sup>rd</sup>	6
4 <sup>th</sup>	5

Place	Points
5 <sup>th</sup>	4
6 <sup>th</sup>	3
7 <sup>th</sup>	2
8 <sup>th</sup>	1

- After "Meet Points" are accumulated from all finishers in the Bike Race Meet, company winners will be determined and points will be awarded, by division, to your *overall* KCCC total, as follows:

Place	Points
1 <sup>st</sup>	40
2 <sup>nd</sup>	34
3 <sup>rd</sup>	28
4 <sup>th</sup>	24

Place	Points
5 <sup>th</sup>	20
6 <sup>th</sup>	16
7 <sup>th</sup>	12
8 <sup>th</sup>	10

Place	Points
9 <sup>th</sup>	8
10 <sup>th</sup>	6
11 <sup>th</sup>	4
12 <sup>th</sup>	2

- Medals and additional “medal points” will be awarded toward your *overall* KCCC Total for the top three finishers in each age group in the Bike Race. These medals and “medal points” will be awarded overall by age group, not by division. Medal points will be scored as follows:

Place	Points
1 <sup>st</sup>	3
2 <sup>nd</sup>	2
3 <sup>rd</sup>	1

- The KCCC will award participation points for all competitors in the Bike Race. To receive participation points, competitors must complete the event as designed (riders must finish the bike race under their own power).
